


# **Pentecost Sunday**



Many: and the glory was given to the people.





The **image** on the cover is "Pentecost" by Girolamo Muziano.

The paraments are red for the celebration of Pentecost Sunday. The altar display was created by Rev. Brenda Goodman. Pentecost is celebrated fifty days after Easter, on the last Sunday of the Season of Easter, and is symbolized by red for the fire of heaven, the Holy Spirit. The English word "Pentecost" is a transliteration of the Greek word pentekostos, which means "fifty." On Pentecost we commemorate the coming of the Holy Spirit on the early followers of Jesus. Before the events of the first Pentecost, there were followers of Jesus, but no movement that could be meaningfully called "the church." Thus, from an historical point of view, Pentecost is the day on which the church was started. This is also true from a spiritual perspective, since the Spirit brings the church into existence and enlivens it. Thus, Pentecost is the church's birthday.
