Welcome & Time of Greeting



The **paraments** are **green** for the season of Ordinary Time, or "greening" of the Spirit. In the ancient church, this season coincided with the "springing forth" of God's spirit following Pentecost, just as spring bursts forth with new life. There are two periods of Ordinary Time in the liturgical year. The first is after Epiphany Sunday through Ash Wednesday. The second is between the Monday after Pentecost and the first Sunday of Advent. Ordinary Time is the longest season in the liturgical year.

During today's **Offertory**, we are receiving the **One Great Hour of Sharing** offering. OGHS is an offering that makes the love of Christ real for individuals and communities around the world who suffer the effects of disaster, conflict, or severe economic hardship, and for those who serve them through gifts of money and time. Today, projects are underway in more than 100 countries. OGHS funds are used for disaster relief, refugee assistance, development aid, and more. More info can be found at abc-oghs.org.
