## COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP MENU

We welcome partners who want to support families through time, skills, services, and tangible resources that directly build stability and dignity.

### 1. Personal Care & Wellness Services

- Free or donated haircuts and grooming services
- Hair braiding workshops and culturally responsive hair care education
- Skincare or basic self-care clinics
- Nail care or personal grooming pop-up services

### 2. Family Health, Parenting & Early Childhood Support

- Parenting support circles
- Lactation support groups and breastfeeding education
- Infant care workshops (safe sleep, feeding, early bonding)
- Child development and early learning sessions
- Support for navigating infant and toddler care options

### 3. Life Skills & Stability-Building Workshops

- Financial literacy (budgeting, credit building, banking basics)
- Job readiness support (resume help, interview prep, workplace skills)
- Digital literacy (email, job applications, online services)
- Tenant education (rights, responsibilities, preparing for leases)

### 4. Youth Enrichment & Creative Learning

- STEM and hands-on learning activities
- Sports and movement sessions
- Mentorship in specific trades, careers, or college pathways

### 5. Trade & Skill-Based Contributions

- Basic home repair or maintenance education (for families moving into housing)
- Sewing and clothing repair workshops
- Car seat safety checks or basic vehicle maintenance education

## TOP DONATION NEEDS

Families in shelter are often starting over with very little. The most helpful donations right now include:

- **Household essentials for new housing:** sheet sets, comforters, pillows, kitchen starter kits (pots, pans, utensils, dishes), mattresses, bed frames, couches, dressers, and cleaning supplies
- **Children's items:** diapers (all sizes), wipes, infant formula, backpacks, school supplies, and educational toys/books
- **Clothing:** new socks and underwear, seasonal clothing (casual and professional), shoes of all sizes, and plus-size options
- **Hygiene products:** shampoo, conditioner, body wash, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrushes, feminine hygiene products, and diverse hair care products
- **Transportation & flexibility support:** grocery gift cards (King Soopers, Walmart, Target), RTD bus passes, and gas cards (\$10-\$25)
