



# Missions & Advocacy Support

### Bootstraps & Blessings - serving our community

- 24 Volunteers (2 new volunteers)
- Served 286 clients from 11/1/2021 through 10/17/2022
- 168 are experiencing homelessness
- 37 are disabled
- 17 are veterans
- 225 people are dependent on our clients.
- 853 visits from the 286 clients
- 1251 King Soopers Cards (\$6,255) and 1005 RTD Passes (\$2814)
- 349 Showers were taken and 173 people did laundry (some did more than one load a day)
- New washers/dryers were installed by Bill Warren, Ken De-Hate and Gordon Pelton. Very needed and appreciated!
- Hundreds of donations of peanut butter, tuna packets, crackers, granola bars, and more!



With New Hope:

- provided 70 bags filled with books and educational materials to 3 teachers and 70 third graders at Stedman Elementary
- provided 3 gift cards to 3 teachers

### **Family Promise**

- Welcomed 4 families back into our building with a 2 week shift starting August 14-28, 2022
- 74 volunteer shifts filled
- upcoming two-week shift in December

### **Additional Financial Support & Advocacy**

- Supported 14 Calvary families in need/crisis
- Financially supported IM Global Servants Joyce & David Reed, Dwight & Barb Bolick, and Lauran Bethell

# Community Events & Outreach

- Hosted booth at Denver PRIDEFEST, met 100+ neighbors
- 15 Calvary volunteers hosted Calvary's PRIDE table
- 22 children and 21 volunteers participated in Vacation Bible School (most of the children were not previously a part of Calvary)
- At time of printing, we were one week out from Trunk or Treat with a goal of 25 cars! Last year over 200 people came.
- Partnership with the Jewish Family Service ACE Program began in 2021 and they now use our East Wing during the week.
- JFS uses Calvary's parking lot for monthly Mobile Pet Pantry
- Evergreen (ABC-USA) Annual Gathering at First Baptist Denver: 4 van volunteers & 11 participants & 3 pastors leading
