

to dream God's dreams, receive God's power, and do God's deeds.





You can use cash or credit or debit card to load your card. Use the card every time you shop and Calvary receives 5%. Your shopping receipt will show the balance on the card, and you can reload the card with more money whenever it is getting low. It is important to not let the card go to zero and stay empty for a month. It will deactivate at that point. *You can reload the cards at the check stand as well as the service desk, but you must do it before the checker begins to check your groceries. It is a separate transaction. Help out those in our community who need it most!
