Hymnals will be placed throughout the sanctuary; any worshipper may use the hymnal(s) that you gift to the church. To ensure the nameplate printing is correct, you will be able to preview the printed nameplates before and after Sunday services on August 11 and 18.

Calvary will be purchasing 350 hymnals. To ensure as many people are able to participate as possible, there will be an initial maximum order limit of 6 hymnals per individual/couple/family unit. Should you wish to gift more, let us know, and after everyone has had a chance to participate, we will contact you.

The cost to gift a hymnal is \$20. You may write one check to CALVARY BAPTIST CHURCH OF DENVER (put "hymnal" in the memo line of your check), however <u>please fill out a SEPARATE form for each hymnal you are</u> <u>purchasing</u>.

Incorrect Format: This hymnal is given In honor of Mr. and Mrs. Johnson by The Smith Family

If multiple generations/families listed, please use semicolons to differentiate family units. For example:

This hymnal is given in honor of Richard, Suzanne, and Toby Reynolds; Rachel Reynolds; Roger Reynolds & John Jeffery by Rita & Ralph Reynolds
